Meeting Minutes

The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.



Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Johnson opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The February 2017 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update provided by Ed Ward, FDOT Emergency Operations

- There are currently 123 wildfires statewide; the closest to the Alachua-Bradford area are in Green Cove Springs and up around SR 2.
- The hurricane predication for this year is for fewer hurricanes than the past few years.
- There is a statewide task force working on ways to combat waterway debris, as quite a bit of debris still exists from Hurricane Matthew.
- Normal pre-hurricane season preparations occurring currently.

ITS, 511 and RTMC Update provided by Craig Carnes, TMC Consultant Project Manager

- The project to install ITS devices and power infrastructure from SR 24 to the Georgia State Line is progressing and is expected to be completed by Fall 2018.
- A DMS was just installed on US 441 southbound just before Paynes Prairie, and was expected to be final accepted the same day as the TIM meeting.
- FDOT is still working out bugs with the new FL511 App. Attendees were encouraged to submit issues they found with the App.
- The ITS program is moving towards arterial management; as such, the RTMC is looking to assist the Gainesville SmartTraffic Center more in the future.
- FDOT is trying to find funding to be able to execute a contract to have Road Rangers patrol I-75 throughout the Gainesville area.

Construction Project Update provided by Bianca Speights, Public Information Office.

- Bianca Speights will no longer be attending the meetings; FDOT Public Information will be sending someone else to provide construction updates.
- Steve Scanlan provided the following information:
 - The three I-75 resurfacing projects from the Marion County Line to the city of Alachua are still active.

- The NW 23rd Avenue to Alachua section is waiting on friction course to finish; the evenings have still been too cool to lay the friction course.
- The Marion County to Williston Road piece still needs the structural course to be finished.
- The piece in between the two sections above is not getting much attention at the moment.
- US 301 resurfacing going on in Alachua County as well, in two sections.
 - Construction just started on the section from the railroad overpass in Waldo to the Bradford County Line.
 - The preconstruction meeting for the section from SE 202nd to SE 65th (south of Hawthorne) was just held.
- Construction of the Starke Alternate Truck Route is ongoing.
- Resurfacing of US 301 in Bradford County from Carter Road in Lawtey to Clay County has commenced.
- Instead of the I-75 contraflow plan in the event of an evacuation, the new plan for this year is to allow northbound traffic on the inside shoulder, creating 4 northbound lanes. The same plan will be in effect on I-10 from US 301 to I-75, except I-10 will use the outside shoulder.

Incident Debrief – (Ed Ward’s List attached)

- The 3/19/17 crash on I-75 actually resulted in 5 fatalities. The way in which the vehicles came to rest amongst each other made the extrication difficult, but it was able to be done with a rotator from Shelby’s Towing. It is recommended to use the lessons learned from that extrication to educate others on how to apply the resources of heavy duty wreckers to clear crashes. The FHP investigation appears to show that the driver of the at-fault vehicle fell asleep, causing the crash. RISC was not activated since the crash did not cause a road blockage.
- Capt. Tierney mentioned the Open Roads Policy and the importance of getting management to understand the hurdles to clearance time that are faced during actual roadway events.
- A crash in Paynes Prairie that was not on the list was briefly discussed. It appears that the driver fell asleep and ran off the road, into the water. The incident did not cause any lane blockage, although there were onlooker backups.
- Craig Carnes mentioned sharing training information to the team so that all can participate and strengthen the relationships and share knowledge between all team members.

TIM SERIES: TIM Strategic Plan

- Grady Carrick (Enforcement Engineering) and Steve Cyra (HNTB) discussed the TIM Strategic Plan and solicited input from the team members. The conversation wrapped up with Craig and Grady both offering to hold SHRP 2 training, including Train-the-Trainer training. The training can be held at times that are convenient for the agencies, including outside of normal business hours.

511 Presentation

- Stephanie Veraghen, with Global 5, explained the available tools of the new Florida 511 system and how to navigate and personalize the new system.

Agency Reviews – Open Forum

- Alachua Fire Rescue – The governor declared a state of emergency due to the numerous active wildfires across the state and the drought index. A brief discussion on the causes of wildfires ensued. Alachua County does not currently have a burn ban in effect.

- Gainesville Police Department – The 2/21/17 and 3/20/17 crashes from the incident list did not have fatalities.

Closing Remarks

- If anyone is interested in setting up another SHRP2 Incident Management Training Course, please contact Craig Carnes at ccarnes@metriceng.com. He will work with any agencies' schedules, including nights and weekends to make the training course available. He can conduct training for groups of 10 or more students.
- Dee Dee asked for agency volunteers for the presentation. Chris Gilbert volunteered to do a short presentation on Hazardous Materials for the next meeting.
- The next Alachua/Bradford Traffic Incident Management Team meeting will be June 14th, 2017 at the FDOT Gainesville Operations Office – 5301 N.E. 39th Ave, Gainesville, Florida.
