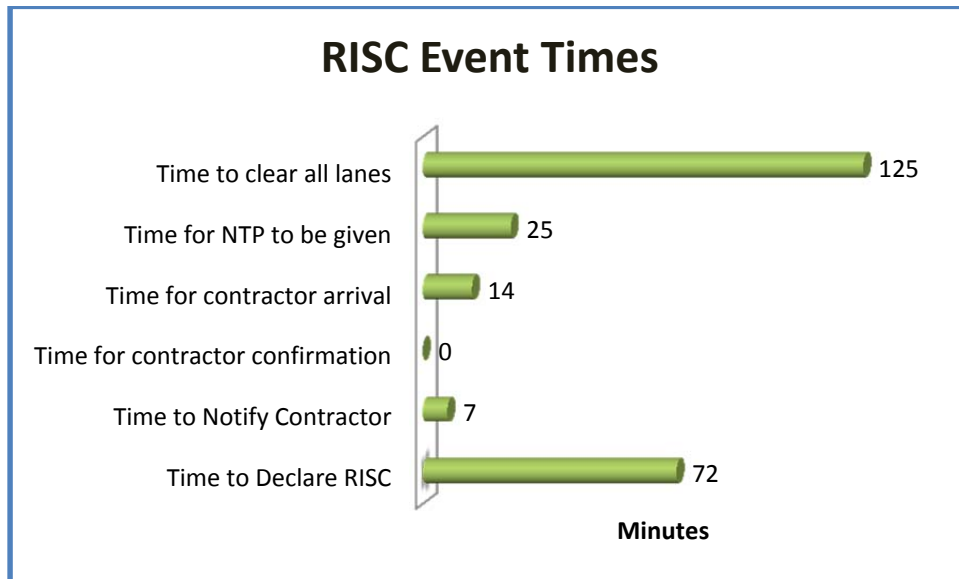
Incident on July 28, 2012

Purpose: Review the RISC Incident to determine successes and areas of improvement for all responders and the TIM Team as a whole.

Date/Time: July 28 at approximately 3:22 PM

Location: I-75 NB at MM 386

Preliminary report: Accident



- Crash occurred 3:22 PM
- All lanes blocked 4:18 PM
- RISC activated by FHP 4:34 PM
- RISC Contractor (University) notified 4:41 PM
- RISC Contractor en route 4:41 PM
- RISC contractor arrived 4:55 PM (14 minutes)
- Notice to Proceed given by FHP 5:20 PM
- RISC on standby due to overturned Rotator Truck 5:59 PM
- Notice to Proceed is given by FHP 6:39 PM
- All vehicles/debris removed – RISC complete 8:05 PM (125 minutes)
- Secondary Crash while clean-up of hydraulic fluid was done 8:43 PM
- All lanes open at Primary accident scene 8:51 PM
- All lanes open at Secondary accident scene 9:27 PM

- Donna welcomed all to the RISC debrief. She reviewed the incident timeline, as shown above.
- Donna asked for input from the various agencies who had responded.
- FHP
 - Traffic had been diverted throughout the event and clean-up. Other than the mishap with the rotator truck, University did a great job.
- DEP
 - DEP was not aware of any issues.
- TMC
 - Donna and Ryan stated the TMC Operator that was working did not call University Towing to inform them of the RISC Activation because she had already logged that University Towing was on-scene as the rotational wrecker. University Towing should have been notified on the RISC activation. This issue has been discussed with all personnel and will not happen again.
- University Towing
 - A cable failed on the rotator truck which caused it to overturn, which necessitated a new truck brought to the scene.
- Alachua Sheriff's Office
 - ASO was not aware of any issues.
- FDOT Maintenance
 - FDOT Maintenance was not aware of any issues.
- Fire Department
 - The Fire Department was not present.
- The bonus will not be paid for this event due to going over 90 minutes from NTP to open all travel lanes.
- The meeting was adjourned.
