

**ALACHUA TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT
TEAM MEETING MINUTES
August 11, 2010**

- Donna welcomed everyone and stated the purpose of the team meeting.
- No construction and road closure updates were presented from our PIO Office because Gina and Lorrie were on vacation. However, Steve Scanlan gave a brief report on the construction on US 301 and SR 26 and on reconfiguring the signal in Hawthorne. He also mentioned the SR 26 project should be completed by the end of the Year.
- The Emergency Operations Center report from Ed Ward – tropical depression is in the Gulf headed to LA and should be a storm by the time it reaches. Ed also spoke about the training from Department of Emergency Management given on August 3rd at the Lake City District Office. The training was very brief and fast and he was disappointed.
- Alachua County is updating their evacuation plans and how to deal with the mass of people that would be coming into Alachua County area. The contra flow exercise was conducted last week with DOT, FHP and it went well. The statewide evacuation is coming to a close with the consultants doing a survey with over 100,000 people on Behavior and Transports. Also, the airport will be doing an exercise and will need signs from FDOT; the Navy will be bringing in the planes.
- No report from City of Gainesville
- RISC has not been used but the contract has been renewed and funding has been approved.
- ITS/511- No new update

- Incident Debriefing was presented by Ed Ward (see attachment). The team voted to include other areas into the incident report: Baker, Bradford, and Union Counties.
- Team Concerns: The issue was brought up about having a TIM Team in other areas. Donna stated the issue has been discussed with her supervisor and it has been decided new Teams are not needed. She will discuss with new management.
- A new contract has been signed for the Road Rangers with the option of having sponsors in hopes of expanding the program. The Road Rangers can be dispatched as far as SR 228 in Baker County if FHP has a need.
- Hurricane Tips, the *Time4Safety Video* and the Diversion Routes CD's were offered. Ed Ward advised he was having difficulty accessing mile post locations – Donna will contact Craig Carnes with Metric for assistance.
